



- ⇒ **CAPSON**, the Council of AP Schools in Ontario, founded in 2002, is an association of AP schools in Ontario and Quebec that allows members to share concerns and strategies to implement and expand the AP program in their schools
- ⇒ **CAPSON** offers an opportunity to **network** and exchange **best practices** with other Ontario AP schools through the electronic discussion group. AP Coordinators and all AP teachers in CAPSON school may join but each must register him/herself on the **CAPSON directory** [www.netdirectories.com/~capson/login.cgi](http://www.netdirectories.com/~capson/login.cgi).
- ⇒ **CAPSON** members receive electronic newsletters throughout the year.
- ⇒ **CAPSON** produces an annual update on Ontario **University policies** and a contact list for their Admissions personnel through a month email.
- ⇒ **CAPSON** has compiled and shares a list of **AP resources** used in Ontario AP schools.
- ⇒ **CAPSON** schools **advocate** as a group to the Universities and the Ministry of Education. It is thanks to CAPSON initiatives that ALL Ontario universities now grant AP credits and that students can now indicate their AP status on the **OUAC application** form. We will continue to press for expanded acceptance of AP courses.
- ⇒ **CAPSON's mentor program** connects new AP teachers with an experienced Ontario AP teacher who will act as their mentor. Contact Lynda Robinson to arrange this.
- ⇒ **CAPSON** organizes a **reception for AP National Scholars**, their family, friends and teachers.
- ⇒ **CAPSON** presents a **CAPSON Scholarship** to each AP National Scholar from a member school.
